In this context, examine case studies from leading companies to understand the application of successful sustainability practices (such as circular economy and regenerative economy).
- 4. Identify best practices for building an inclusive green environment and encourage employee green behaviours. Participants will learn to craft effective communication strategies to convey the company's sustainability efforts to various stakeholders.
- 5. Explore role of digital technology within sustainability landscape to prepare for future sustainability trends and anticipate potential regulatory changes to stay ahead in sustainability efforts.
